Non-waxed or coated, flattened



CDs, 3.5" FLOPPY DISKS, VIDEO TAPES



CELL PHONES

Including batteries, chargers, adapters.



COMPUTER PERIPHERALS

Hard drives, keyboards, printers, mice

NOT ACCEPTED

Computer monitors, desktop/laptop computers, televisions

These can be recycled for free year-round through E-Cycle Washington. Visit www.ecyclewashington.org for more information.



CONFIDENTIAL MATERIAL SHREDDING

Shredding and recycling of confidential paper materials. Shredding on site by request. Limit: Five file-size (12" x 12" x 16") boxes or equivalent. No exceptions.



PLASTICS

Grocery bags, garment bags, stretch wrap, film, bubble wrap, shrink wrap



REFRIGERATORS, FREEZERS, AIR CONDITIONERS

Fee: \$10 each (cash only)



SCRAP METAL, ELECTRONICS

Chairs, desks, file cabinets, telephones, fax machines, typewriters, adding machines, copiers, other ferrous and non-ferrous metals

NOT ACCEPTED

Metals that are insulated, rubber, or oil coated; previously or currently contain gas, oil, chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials; light fixture ballasts; sealed tanks and drums



TONER, INKJET, PRINTER CARTRIDGES



WOOD PALLETS, UNTREATED SCRAP WOOD

THESE ITEMS ARE NOT ACCEPTED AT THIS EVENT. RECYCLE THEM YEAR-ROUND AT OTHER LOCATIONS.

FLUORESCENT LIGHTS, TUBES, AND BULBS

OIL-BASED PAINT, CHEMICALS, CLEANING PRODUCTS, AND OTHER HAZARDOUS WASTE
