**Only the Following Items Will be Accepted.....**



**You Can Bring...**

• **TIRES:** Bias ply, steel belted, and studded tires accepted. **Limit 6 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge. \$1.50 charge for each tire on a rim. \$5 charged for each large truck tire and \$15 charged for each truck tire on rim (cash only).** **No oversized tires accepted.**



• **MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, & ANTIFREEZE:** Motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze, brake fluid, transmission fluid, 2-cycle oil, steering fluid, crankcase oil, kerosene, and home heating fuel. Do not mix oil with antifreeze, solvents, gasoline, or other substances. Empty oil or antifreeze containers will not be accepted.



• **LEAD ACID BATTERIES:** Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted.

• **HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries. **New** - also accepted are rechargeable batteries and cellphone batteries.

• **CARDBOARD:** Please flatten. No wax coated cardboard.

• **HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND CLOTHING:** Clothing and miscellaneous household items in good condition. Furniture and items in need of repair will not be accepted.

• **CONFIDENTIAL MATERIAL SHREDDING:** Shredding and recycling of confidential paper materials. **Limit 5 file-size boxes. No exceptions.**

• **PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS:** Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed. **\$10 charge (cash only).**

• **PROPANE TANKS:** Residential five gallon tanks only. **\$5 charge (cash only).**

• **REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS/HOUSEHOLD AIR CONDITIONERS:** **\$10 (new price) will be charged for each refrigerator, freezer, or household air conditioner (cash only).**

• **APPLIANCES AND SCRAP METAL:** Stoves, microwaves, washers, dryers, other appliances, metal push and gas lawnmowers (drained of oil and gasoline), auto parts, lawn chairs, barbecues, iron, steel, aluminum, brass, copper, and other ferrous and non-ferrous metals free of charge. **\$5 will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating (cash only).** Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials will not be accepted. Light fixture ballasts and sealed drums will not be accepted. **Any item that contains gas or oil will be rejected.**

• **ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT:** DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, cellular phones and computer peripherals such as keyboards and mice. **Computer monitors and televisions will not be accepted. You can recycle these items for free at other locations - see the E-Cycle box for more information.**

• **STYROFOAM BLOCKS AND PACKING PEANUTS:** White styrofoam blocks. Packing peanuts (any color). **No urethane foam cushions, hot tub covers, expanded polypropylene or foam insulation.** Expanded polystyrene only. Look for the #6 or EPS inside the recycling symbol. **Packing peanuts: please keep in box or bag. Materials must be clean and dry.**

• **MATTRESSES:** Mattresses, box springs and futons, any size. **Fee: \$10 per mattress, box spring, or futon (cash only).** Vendor reserves the right to refuse any item it cannot recycle. **No furniture or frames. No wet or soiled items.**

• **CLEAN SCRAP WOOD:** Milled lumber, plywood, and pallets. **These wood products must be untreated and unpainted. Please do NOT bring furniture, yard waste, stumps, branches, construction or demolition material, as it will NOT be accepted.**



**These household wastes:**

- No construction/demolition debris
- No garbage
- No furniture
- No plastic toys, hoses, etc.
- No window glass
- No plastics

**These household hazardous wastes:**

**No paint of any kind**

- No pesticides/herbicides
- No solvents or thinners
- No household chemicals
- No cleaning products
- No fluorescent lights

**Household hazardous wastes** can be taken to the Household Hazardous Wastemobile and the hazardous waste collection site in Factoria. The Factoria site is located at 13800 SE 32<sup>nd</sup> Street, Bellevue. The site is open 8 am - 4 pm Tuesday - Friday and 9 am - 5 pm Saturday and Sunday (except major holidays). There is a 50 gallon limit and a gasoline limit of 30 gallons per customer per day and customers will not get their containers back. No containers can be over five gallons in size. Separate motor (crankcase) oil from all other fluids. Pure crankcase oil containers will be returned. **No latex paint is accepted.** Visit <http://www.lhwmp.org/home/HHW/disposal-locations.aspx#factoria> for more information.

Mercer Island has an E-Cycle Washington location for the **FREE** recycling of computers, computer monitors, televisions, portable DVD players, laptop computers, and tablet computers, and e-readers (also called e-book readers). **LOCATION: 7835 SE 30th Street, Mercer Island, WA 98040. PHONE: 206-230-8188. HOURS: 10:00am - 6:00pm Mon.-Sat.** Please note that computer peripherals such as keyboards, mice, and printers are not included in this program but will be accepted at City Recycling Events. Beware, it is always a good idea to delete or remove all personal information from any item you are recycling - better safe than sorry.

# Rain Barrel Sale

To help residents use water more efficiently, the City of Mercer Island is selling rain barrels. These high-quality rain barrels are being made available to City residents at a reduced cost. The rain barrels normally retail for about \$120, but residents will pay only \$25. Quantities are limited. Holds up to 55 gallons of rainwater.


