Household Hazardous Wastes can be taken to the Household Hazardous Wastemobile or one of four household hazardous waste collection sites. The Household Wastemobile will visit **Covington on June 13, 14, and 15, 2014**. Hours are from 10 am to 5 pm. Location: **Fred Meyer - 16735 SE 272 ST in Covington**. Volume restrictions apply. Please segregate motor oil from all other fluids.

Only the Following Items Will be Accepted.....



You Can Bring...

• **TIRES:** Limit 6 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge. \$1.50 charge for each tire on a rim. \$5 charged for each large truck tire and \$15 charged for each truck tire on rim (*cash only*). No oversized tires accepted.

• **MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, & ANTIFREEZE:** Motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze, brake fluid, transmission fluid, 2-cycle oil, steering fluid, crankcase oil, kerosene, and home heating fuel. Do not mix with antifreeze, solvents, gasoline, or other substances.

• **LEAD ACID BATTERIES:** Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted.

• **BATTERIES:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries. Also accepted are rechargeable batteries and cellphone batteries.

• **CARDBOARD:** Please flatten. No wax coated cardboard.

• **HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND CLOTHING:** Clothing and miscellaneous household items in good condition. Items in need of repair will not be accepted.

• **PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS:** \$10 charge (*cash only*). Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed.

• **PROPANE TANKS:** Residential tanks only. \$5 charge (*cash only*).

• **BULKY WOOD:** Includes tree branches (minimum 6 inches in diameter), logs, clean wood, plywood, pallets, and other untreated and unpainted wood. **No peg board, particle or press board. No leaves, grass, small branches, sod, or brush.** Please lay a tarp under material for ease of removal.

• **APPLIANCES AND SCRAP METAL:** Household appliances, auto parts, engines, metal lawn chairs, stoves, barbecues, gas lawnmowers (drained of oil and gasoline), iron, steel, aluminum, brass, copper, and other ferrous and nonferrous metals. **\$5 will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating (*cash only*).** Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain **gas, oil**, chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials will not be accepted. Light fixture ballasts and sealed drums will not be accepted.

• **REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS:** \$10 will be charged for each refrigerator, freezer, and household air conditioner (*cash only*).

• **MATTRESSES:** mattresses, box springs and futons, any size. **\$10 per mattress, box spring, or futon (*cash only*).** Vendor reserves the right to refuse any item it cannot recycle. No furniture or frames. No wet or soiled items.

• **ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT:** DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, cellular phones (**remove personal information**) and computer peripherals such as keyboards and mice. **Computer monitors and televisions will not be accepted.** You can recycle these items for free at other locations - see the E-Cycle box below for more information.



E-Cycle Washington

Use E-Cycle Washington sites for computers, computer monitors, laptops, and televisions. Call 1-800-RECYCLE or visit 1800recycle.wa.gov to find authorized E-Cycle Washington collection locations. In the Covington area you may drop off computers, computer monitors, laptops, portable DVD players, and televisions at no charge at the following locations: [Maple Valley Goodwill Store \(27077 MV-Black Diamond RD SE in Maple Valley, 253-573-6710\)](#) and [Command Computers \(23220 Maple Valley Highway SE, Suite 3-D, 425-413-0808\)](#). Note - drop off locations and conditions may change. Quantities accepted may be limited. Please also note that computer peripherals such as keyboards, mice, and printers are not included in this program but will be accepted at the City Recycling Collection Events. Beware, it is always a good idea to delete or remove all personal information from any item you are recycling - better safe than sorry.

Rain Barrel Sale

To help residents use water more efficiently, the City of Covington is selling rain barrels. These high-quality rain barrels are being made available to City residents at a reduced cost. The rain barrels normally retail for about \$120, but residents will pay only \$25. Quantities are limited. Holds up to 53 gallons of rainwater.
