NO metals that are insulated, rubber coated, oily, previously or currently contain chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials. NO light fixture ballasts. NO sealed drums.	
Refrigerators, Freezers & Air Conditioners	Refrigerators, freezers, and portable household air conditioners.	NO industrial fridges and freezers.	\$10 (new price) for each. Cash only.
Toilets & Sinks	Toilet seat, and wax ring on base must be removed.		\$10 each item. Cash only.
Electronics	DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, cell phones, CPUs and accessories like a keyboard or mouse.	NO computer monitors, laptop computers, TVs.	Find free drop-off locations for computers, laptops & TV's at 1-800-RECYCLE.

Propane Tanks	Residential tanks only.		
Bulky Yard Debris	Logs and large branches greater than four inches in diameter.	NO brush, sod, grass clippings, blackberry bushes, leaves, small branches, rocks or stumps.	Place on tarp for easy removal.
Scrap Wood	Clean wood and pallets.	NO painted, stained, treated or laminated wood or particle board.	Place on tarp for easy removal. No need to remove nails.
Reusable Household Goods	Clothing and miscellaneous household items in good condition.	NO broken, torn, stained, damaged or wet items. NO furniture.	All items must be clean and in good enough condition for resale by a charitable organization.
Document Shredding	Limit of 3 file-size boxes per vehicle - no exceptions.		
Concrete, Asphalt, Rock & Brick Sand from Sandbags	Place on tarp for easy removal. Rocks and smaller materials including sand must be in boxes or buckets.	NO bags, just the sand inside.	Remove plastic, metal and wood. Residential material only.
Mattresses	Mattresses, box springs, and futons, any size.	No commercial loads. No wet/soiled items.	FREE ONE TIME ONLY.
Infant, Child and Booster Car Seats	Seats that can be refurbished will be given away to WestSide Baby's partnership with local social service agencies; seats that don't pass inspection will be recycled.		Car seats under 6 yrs. can be reused, car seats 6 yrs. & older will be recycled.

NO flatbeds or dump trucks allowed. Vendors reserve the right to refuse oversized, commercial, contaminated, excessive or unacceptable loads.

DON'T BRING THESE HOUSEHOLD WASTES:

- **NO** tires
- **NO** construction/demolition debris
- **NO** motor oil, filters, antifreeze, or petroleum based products
- **NO** styrofoam
- **NO** plastics
- **NO** grass, leaves, or small yard debris
- **NO** garbage
- **NO** window glass/mirrors
- **NO** latex paint (see note below)
- **NO** plastic pools, toys, hoses, etc.
- **NO** painted/treated wood
- **NO** carpeting

Latex paint, if less than a quarter can-full, may be dried out by leaving the lid off, and placed in the garbage once dry. Share larger amounts with friends, donate to a local theater group, or dry by adding equal amounts of cat litter or paint hardener. DON'T BRING THESE HAZARDOUS WASTES:

- **NO** paint of any kind
- **NO** solvents and thinners
- **NO** cleaning products
- **NO** pesticides/herbicides
- **NO** household chemicals
- **NO** fluorescent lights
