Sunny Hills and Discovery Elementary Schools

Only the Following Items Will be Accepted at Sunny Hills School:

- **TIRES:** Bias ply, steel belted, and studded tires accepted. Limit 6 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge. **\$1.50 charge for each tire on a rim. \$5 charged for each large truck tire and \$15 charged for each truck tire on rim (cash only). No oversized tires accepted.**
- **MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, & ANTIFREEZE:** Motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze, brake fluid, transmission fluid, 2-cycle oil, steering fluid, crankcase oil, kerosene, and home heating fuel. Do not mix with antifreeze, solvents, gasoline, or other substances. Empty oil or antifreeze containers will not be accepted.



- **MATTRESSES - Mattresses and box springs, any size. Fee: \$10 per mattress and per box spring. Vendor reserves the right to refuse any item it cannot recycle. No furniture or frames. No wet or soiled items.**
- **STYROFOAM BLOCKS AND PACKING PEANUTS -** White styrofoam blocks. Packing peanuts (any color). **No urethane foam cushions, hot tub covers, expanded polypropylene or foam insulation.** Expanded polystyrene only. Look for the #6 or EPS inside the recycling symbol. **Packing peanuts: please keep in box or bag. Materials must be clean and dry.**
- **HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND CLOTHING:** Clothing and miscellaneous household items in good condition. Furniture and items in need of repair will not be accepted.
- **CARDBOARD:** Please flatten. No wax coated cardboard.
- **PROPANE TANKS:** Residential five gallon tanks only. **\$5 charge (cash only).**
- **PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS:** Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed. **\$10 charge (cash only).**
- **APPLIANCES AND SCRAP METAL:** Auto parts, appliances, microwaves, stoves, engines and gas lawnmowers (**drained of oil and gasoline**), barbecues, iron, steel, aluminum, brass, copper, and other ferrous and nonferrous metals. **\$5 will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating (cash only).** Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contains **oil, gas**, chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials will not be accepted. Light fixture ballasts and sealed drums will not be accepted.

Only the Following Items Will be Accepted at Discovery Elementary School:

- **ELECTRONIC/COMPUTER EQUIPMENT:** DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, and cellular phones (**remove personal information**). Computers and computer monitors (**no charge**), mouse, keyboards, **tablet computers, and e-readers.**
- **TELEVISION SETS:** TV sets encased in plastic, wood console, sets encased in wood, and big screen TVs accepted (**no charge**).
- **REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS:** **\$10 will be charged for each refrigerator, freezer, and household air conditioner (cash only).**
- **LEAD ACID BATTERIES:** Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted.
- **BATTERIES:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries. Also accepted are rechargeable batteries and cellphone batteries.



E-Cycle Washington

FREE recycling of computers, computer monitors, laptops, and televisions - visit 1800recycle.wa.gov for an authorized E-Cycle Washington location. You may drop off computers, computer monitors, laptops, and televisions for free at the following E-Cycle Washington locations: AtWork! Recycling (970 7th Ave NW Issaquah, WA 98027, 425-274-4020) and Goodwill Bellevue Store (14515 NE 20th St, Bellevue, WA, 98007, 425-649-2080). Please note - drop off locations and conditions may change. Quantities accepted maybe limited - call first. Please also note that computer peripherals such as keyboards, mice, and printers are not included in this program but will be accepted at City Recycling Collection Events. Beware, it is always a good idea to delete or remove all personal information from any item you are recycling - better safe than sorry.

DON'T BRING!



These household wastes:

- No paint of any kind**
- No bulky or scrap wood
- No construction/demolition debris
- No garbage
- No furniture
- No plastic toys, hoses, etc.
- No window glass

These hazardous wastes:

- No oil based paint
- No pesticides/herbicides
- No solvents or thinners
- No household chemicals
- No cleaning products
- No fluorescent lights

Household hazardous wastes can be taken to the Household Hazardous Wastemobile and the hazardous waste collection site in Factoria. The Factoria site is located at 13800 SE 32nd Street, Bellevue. The site is open 8 am - 4 pm Tuesday - Friday and 9 am - 5 pm Saturday and Sunday (except major holidays). There is a 50 gallon limit and a gasoline limit of 30 gallons per customer per day and customers will not get their containers back. No containers can be over five gallons in size. Separate motor (crankcase) oil from all other fluids. Pure crankcase oil containers will be returned. **No latex paint is accepted.**

To encourage the use of recycled content material and more efficient use of water, the City is offering recycled plastic **rain barrels** at a huge discount. In addition, start backyard composting with a **compost bin** to save resources and money. Composting is a natural process that turns yard waste into rich soil. Yard waste contains mostly water. Once the material decomposes, rich soil is all that's left.



Worm bin composting is an efficient way to convert kitchen scraps into nutrient-rich compost for your garden. Simple to assemble and can be stored in or outside. Made in the US and constructed from high quality recycled plastic-\$25 each.
