

These items accepted for recycling.....

Appliances & Scrap Metal

Aluminum, auto parts, barbecues, brass, copper, dryers, electric lawnmowers (remove battery first), iron, metal lawn chairs, metal push and gas lawnmowers (drain oil and gasoline first), microwaves, refrigerators/freezers (\$15 cash only fee will be charged for each refrigerator or freezer brought to the event), steel, stoves, washers, and water heaters (\$5 cash only fee will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating). No containers that previously or currently contain gas, oil, chemicals or paint will be accepted.

Batteries - Lead Acid Only

Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle lead acid type batteries only.

Cardboard

Please flatten. No wax coated cardboard.

Clean Scrap Wood

Milled lumber, plywood, and pallets. These wood products must be untreated and unpainted. Please do NOT bring furniture, yard waste, stumps, branches, construction or demolition material, as it will NOT be accepted.

Electronic Equipment

Blu-ray/DVD players, cellular phones (remove personal information first), computer keyboards, computer mice, copiers, fax machines, printers, scanners, stereo equipment, and VCRs. Beware, it is always a good idea to remove all personal information from any item you are recycling - better safe than sorry.

Mattresses

Mattresses and box springs, any size. Fee: \$10 per mattresses and \$10 per box spring - cash only. Vendor reserves the right to refuse any item it cannot recycle. No furniture or frames. No wet or soiled items.



A secured load has been fastened or attached to the vehicle with tarps, rope, straps, netting, or chains, so as to prevent any part of the load or the covering from becoming loose, detached, or leaving the vehicle while the vehicle is moving.

Porcelain Toilets and Sinks

Toilets and sinks will be accepted for a \$10 cash only fee. Toilet seats, hardware and base wax rings must be removed.

Propane Tanks

Residential tanks will be accepted for a \$5 cash only fee.

Rigid Plastics - New Item

Buckets, children's toys, coolers, laundry baskets, plastic lawn furniture, PVC pipes, and sports bottles.

Styrofoam Blocks and Packing Peanuts

White styrofoam blocks and packing peanuts (any color). No urethane foam cushions, hot tub covers, expanded polypropylene or foam insulation. Expanded polystyrene only. Look for the #6 or EPS inside the recycling symbol. Please keep packing peanuts in box or bag. Materials must be clean and dry.

Textiles and Reusable Household Goods

Clothing and miscellaneous household items in usable condition are accepted. Tax receipts available to donors. NO items in need of repair, carpet, area rugs, or furniture.

Tires

Bias ply, steel belted, and studded tires accepted. Limit 6 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge. \$1.50 charge for each tire on a rim. \$5 charged for each large truck tire and \$15 charged for each truck tire on rim. All fees are cash only. No oversized tires accepted.

Now offered curbside!

Republic Services now offers free expanded recycling options at the curb to Bellevue customers. To schedule a free curbside pick-up of scrap metal items, small appliances, or small electronics (2 feet by 2 feet by 2 feet or smaller and less than 60 pounds), call Republic Services at 425-452-4762.



Free Hazardous Waste Disposal Options for Residents:

The Factoria Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Service is located in Bellevue and accepts the following items free of charge:

- Automotive fluids, cleaning products, oil-based paints, pesticides, and petroleum products (maximum container size of 5 gallons)
- Fluorescent light bulbs and tubes (limit 10 per load)
- Household, vehicle, and marine batteries (limit 5 each per day)
- Propane tanks (8 gallon maximum)
- Thermostats and thermometers

Please note: There is a 50-gallon limit and a gasoline limit of 30 gallons per customer per day. Customers will not get their containers back. No containers can be more than five gallons in size. Separate motor (crankcase) oil from all other fluids. Pure crankcase oil containers will be returned.
