<b>Appliances and Scrap Metal</b>	Washers, dryers, dishwashers, ovens, stoves, water heaters, engines, microwaves, BBQs, lawnmowers, metal lawn chairs, swing sets, cast iron sinks and tubs, auto parts, iron, steel, aluminum (cans included), brass, copper & other ferrous and non-ferrous metals.	Drain all liquids. Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, or currently contain chemicals, gas, oil, paint or hazardous materials will not be accepted. Light fixture ballasts and sealed drums will not be accepted.
<b>Propane Tanks</b>	Residential tanks only.	No charge
<b>Porcelain Toilets &amp; Sinks</b>		Toilet seat, base & wax rings must be removed.
<b>Refrigerators, Freezers and Air Conditioners</b>		No commercial units or automobile air conditioners.
<b>Televisions, Computer Monitors &amp; Laptops</b>	<b>Not accepted at event</b>	Take to the Kent Goodwill Store, 25814 102nd Pl. SE any day at no charge. More info at 253.573.1333
<b>Electronic Equipment</b>	DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, cellular phones, CPUs, and computer peripherals such as keyboards and mice.	<b>No computer monitors, laptops or TVs</b>
<b>Tires: Car, Light Truck &amp; Motorcycle</b>	Bias ply, steel belted, and studded tires accepted. Limit 10 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge. Tires on rims are \$3.50 each.	<b>No oversized tires or truck tires accepted.</b>
<b>Reusable Household Goods</b>	Small appliances in working condition, reusable clothing, shoes, pots, pans, bedding, books and toys. All items must be clean and in good condition for resale by a charity.	<b>No broken, torn, stained or wet items. No furniture or carpet.</b>
<b>Document Shredding</b>	Limit of 3 file-size boxes per vehicle—no exceptions.	
<b>Concrete, Asphalt, Rock &amp; Brick</b>	Place on tarp for easy removal. Rocks and smaller materials must be in boxes or buckets.	Remove plastic, metal and wood. Residential material only.
<b>Cardboard</b>	Please flatten boxes.	No wax-coated cardboard.
<b>Batteries</b>	Car, truck, marine and motorcycle batteries. Alkaline Batteries AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, & D cell batteries only.	
<b>Styrofoam Blocks &amp; Packing Peanuts</b>	White Styrofoam blocks: Expanded polystyrene only; look for the #6 or EPS inside the recycling symbol; keep packing peanuts (any color) in a bag or box; all materials must be clean and dry.	<b>No urethane foam cushions, hot tub covers, expanded polypropylene or foam insulation.</b>

**PLEASE NOTE: No vehicles admitted after 3 p.m. No flatbeds or dump trucks allowed. We reserve the right to refuse oversized, commercial, contaminated, excessive or unacceptable loads.**

*This program is only for household materials from King County residents. Funding provided by City of Kent Public Works Department, King County Solid Waste Division, The WA State Department of Ecology Waste 2 Resources Program and the Local Hazardous Waste Management Program in King County.*

### DON'T BRING THESE HOUSEHOLD WASTES:

- NO construction/demolition debris
- NO grass, leaves, or small yard debris
- NO window glass/mirrors
- NO plastic or plastic pools, toys, hoses, etc.
- NO carpeting
- NO bulky wood
- NO garbage
- NO latex paint (see note below)
- NO painted/treated wood
- NO mattresses

Latex paint, if less than a quarter can-full, may be dried out by leaving the lid off, and placed in the garbage once dry. Share larger amounts with friends, donate to a local theater group, or dry by adding equal amounts of cat litter or paint hardener. Donate full cans to Habitat for Humanity: 206.292.5240

### DON'T BRING THESE HAZARDOUS WASTES:

- NO paint of any kind
- NO solvents and thinners
- NO cleaning products
- NO motor oil, filters, and antifreeze
- NO pesticides/herbicides
- NO household chemicals
- NO fluorescent lights

Household hazardous waste can be disposed of at the Wastemobile in Auburn at The Outlet Collection (formerly known as the SuperMall) 10am-5pm, every Saturday and Sunday, near the loading docks and Sports Authority.
