

King County Shingles in Paving Demo Project *Stakeholder Meeting*

King County Solid Waste Division and the LinkUp Program invite you to join a discussion about how to develop a hot mix asphalt (HMA) end market for tear-off asphalt shingles by conducting a paving trial that incorporates this material. The meeting will include a presentation from and discussions with Dan Krivit, a nationally known and published expert in the use of shingles in HMA.

The meeting will focus on the background of tear-off shingle recycling, including what is happening nationally; an overview of possible research questions for the project; and obtaining input, suggestions and ideas from stakeholders. We hope to identify opportunities, challenges and pitfalls during the discussion.

Here are a few facts:

- An estimated 17,000 to 18,000 tons of asphalt shingle waste generated in King County (excluding Seattle) is disposed of annually.
- Five states (MO, ME, SC, WI, NY) allow the use of tear-off shingles in HMA.
- The American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials is currently reviewing a provisional specification for the use of reclaimed asphalt shingles as an additive in HMA.
