



The Take it Back Network

Refer to the inside panel of this brochure to locate organizations that offer convenient options for safely recycling or disposing of certain products that should not be disposed of in the trash. Donate newer, working electronic products to non-profit organizations that can put them to good use.

Hazardous Materials

Electronic equipment may contain lead, mercury, cadmium, brominated flame retardants and other toxic materials that can cause harm to human health and the environment. These products need to be managed properly.

Data Security

Erase the data on your computer, laptop, or tablet hard drive before bringing it in to be recycled or reused. Software programs are available that will permanently destroy data. Visit www.ecy.wa.gov/programs/swfa/eproductrecycle/data.html for information about data security.

Disposal Bans

City of Seattle prohibits the disposal of computer monitors, TVs or any other device containing cathode ray tubes (CRTs) and fluorescent lamps in the garbage and at Seattle transfer stations.


King County prohibits the disposal of TVs, computers, laptop, tablets, monitors and cell phones, fluorescent bulbs (CFLs) and tubes in the garbage and at King County transfer stations and at the household hazardous waste facilities.

Other Recycling Options



E-Cycle Washington is a statewide recycling program that is provided by the electronics producers. Small businesses, residents, schools, and not-for-profit organizations can recycle any brand of the following products at **no cost**: computers, laptops and tablets, monitors, TVs, portable DVD players.

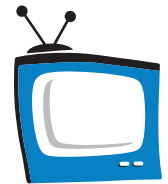
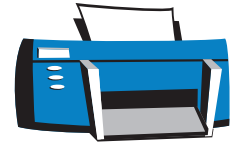
