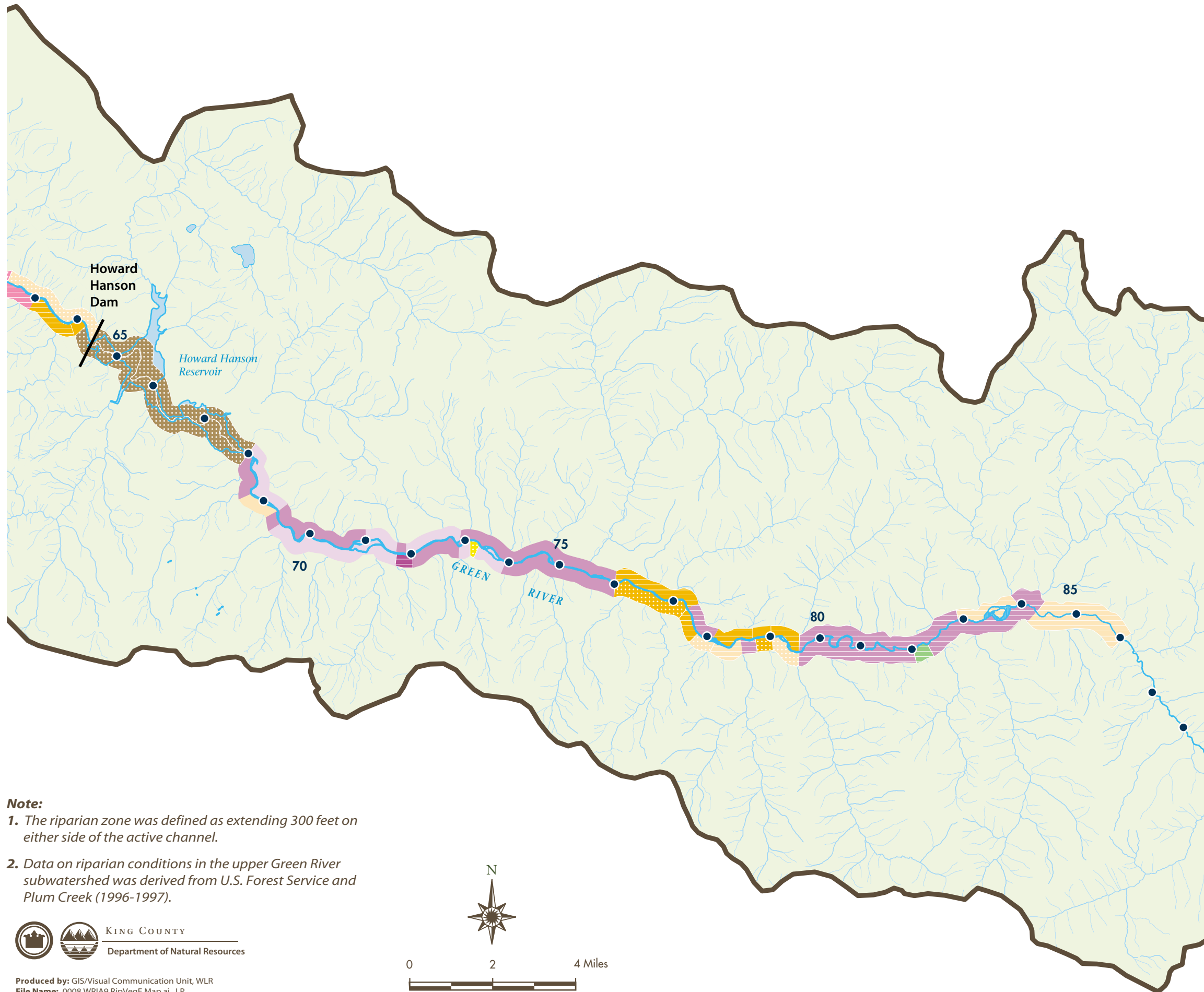


Figure RIP-3

VEGETATION TYPE:

- Bare Ground, Pavement
- Shrub
- Grass, Forb, Field
- Small Deciduous
- Medium Deciduous
- Large Deciduous
- Small Mixed Conifer and Deciduous
- Medium Mixed Conifer and Deciduous
- Large Mixed Conifer and Deciduous
- Medium Conifer

VEGETATION WIDTH:

- 50 Feet or Less
- 50-150 Feet
- 150-300 Feet

Note:

1. The riparian zone was defined as extending 300 feet on either side of the active channel.
2. Data on riparian conditions in the upper Green River subwatershed was derived from U.S. Forest Service and Plum Creek (1996-1997).
