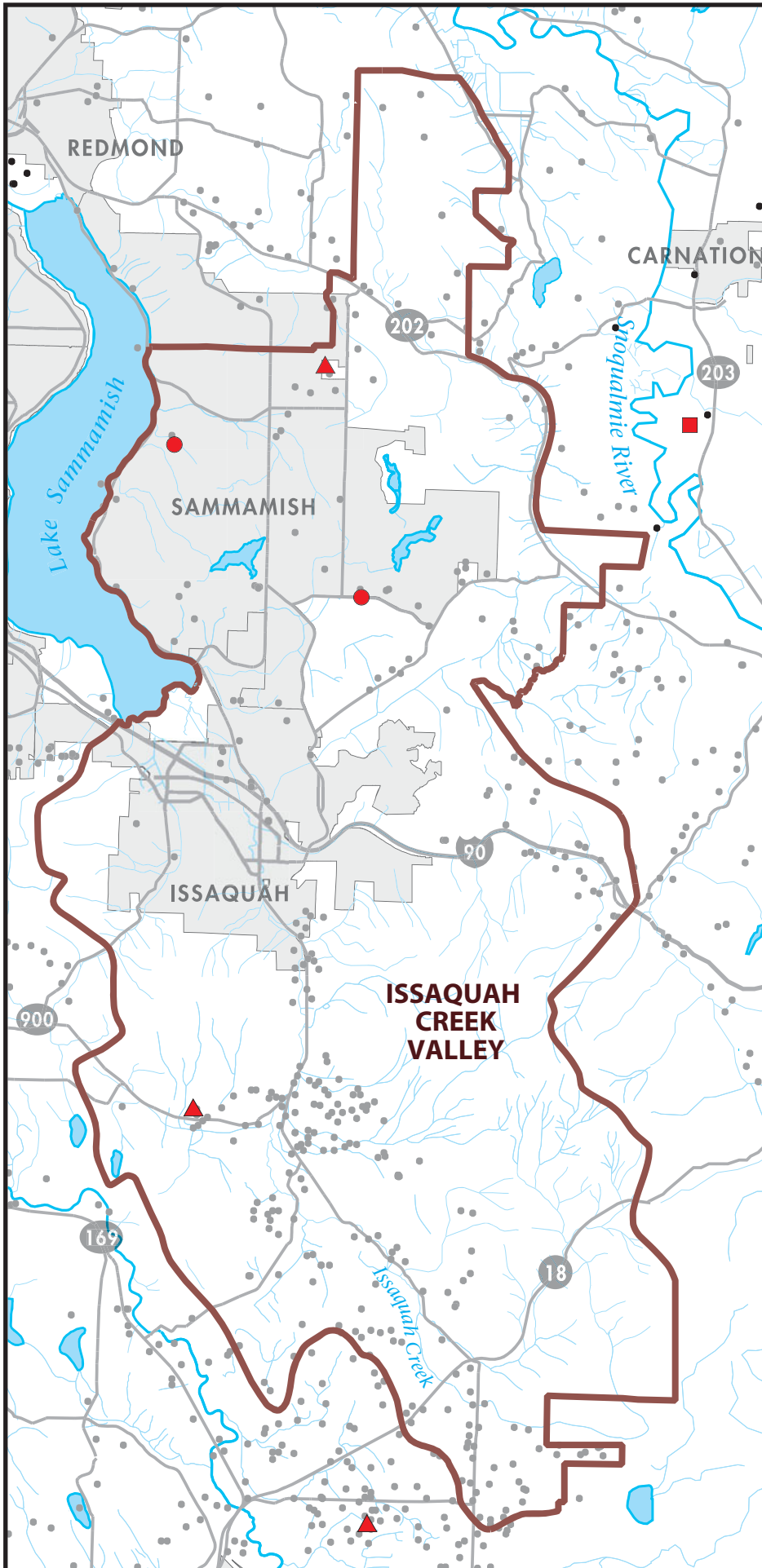


# Issaquah Creek Valley Groundwater Management Area
