

# Forest boats



These containers should merge with the park as best as possible and not violate its visual beauty.

Marine containers used to travel around the seas, but from now on they will be traveling through spaces of King County Parks.

They will turn into cozy refuge for travelers.

Saloon\wardroom will be big enough even for 6 people. The roof of container is covered with greenery, which allows to reduce heating of metal. Walls are painted in light tone, that similarly allows to decrease heating.

From inside walls are insulated with polystyrene foam, finishing cover is OSB.

OSB is an inexpensive waterproof material, that is resistant to extremes of temperature and humidity. In addition it can be painted to achieve a more expressive interior. Floor and

part of the walls are made of polymer composite wood decking planks. This material can be recycled into the same product after it becomes worthless. Cutout part of the wall of a container is used for protection from vandals, while a house is not used and as a sun and rain cover when it is used. Canopy can be

easily lifted by one person, thanks to the counterweight on the other side of the container.

Decoration of the forest boat will be old, used portholes. Berths are designed so that we can

make different versions of these containers. Dividing the container into two cabins with one canopy for a table or splitting into two cabins with individual shelters for the table.
