Waste Reduction and Recycling (Level One)

- Lindbergh reached a recycling rate of 55%.
- Graphics art students and members of the student club Skills USA designed artwork for recycling container lids.
- In 2012-13 the school started to collect recyclable materials in its cafeteria and kitchen.
- Students assisted custodial staff by emptying indoor classroom recycling bins. The custodians managed collection of recycling bins in the cafeteria and kitchen.
- The Green Schools Program provided dollies to help make custodial collection of recyclable materials easier. Student teacher assistants collected recyclable materials from the third floor and transported the materials downstairs for custodial staff to collect.
