Food, yard and wood waste, and compostable paper

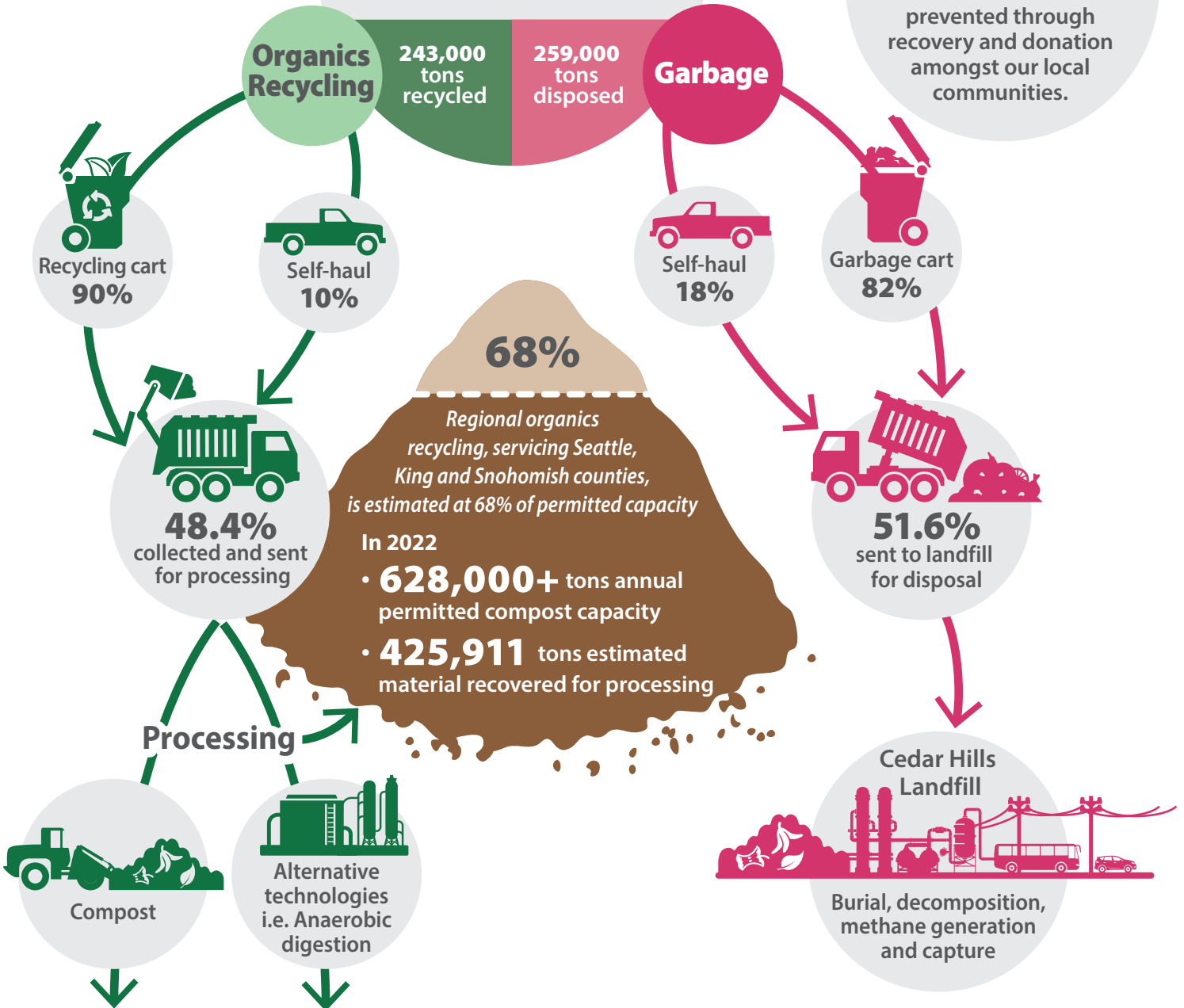
King County's vision is to create a self-sustaining regional organics system that minimizes waste, promotes healthier soils, and protects the environment.
