Notice of Action

Maintenance of Agricultural Drainages in the Snoqualmie Agricultural Production District

Notice is hereby given under SEPA, RCW 43.21C.080, that the Water and Land Resources Division (WLRD), King County Department of Natural Resources and Parks, Agricultural Drainage Assistance Program, took the action described in item 2 below on Friday, January 3, 2011.

1. Any action to set aside, enjoin, review, or otherwise challenge such action on the grounds of non-compliance with the provisions of Chapter 43.21C RCW shall be commenced on or before Tuesday, February 1, 2011.
2. The agency decision is to proceed on final design and construction of the Maintenance of Agricultural Drainages in the Snoqualmie Agricultural Production District.
3. This multi-project SEPA covers the maintenance of the agricultural drainages within or immediately adjacent to land zoned as the Snoqualmie Agricultural Production District in King County. The Snoqualmie Agricultural Production District includes the Snoqualmie Valley from the Snohomish County line south to Fall City (Attachment A). Project will occur on active farms in unincorporated King County, Washington.
4. A Determination of Non-Significance was published and opened for review and public comment from June 9, 2010 through June 23, 2010. Project support documentation and project site maps are available for review at WLRD Offices from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. weekdays. 5. A Decision to Proceed was signed on December 20, 2010 by Joanna Richet, Water & Land Resources Division Assistant Director. This Notice of Action was filed on January 3, 2011 and will continue in effect through February 1, 2011.
