Decision to Proceed

The Rural and Regional Services Section within the Water and Land Resources Division (WLRD) of King County's Department of Natural Resources and Parks has made a "Decision to Proceed" with the Agency Action, as described below.

Proposal Name

Riverbend Mobile Home Park Demolition

Proposal Description

King County proposes to demolish and remove up to 58 mobile homes and associated constructed features of a mobile home park located in the floodplain of the Cedar River. Demolition will include removal of the mobile homes, pavement, concrete and gravel foundations, utilities (water and propane pipes, stormwater catch basins and pipes, sewer pipes and septic tanks, and electrical, telephone and TV transmission cables), fences, playground structures, and restroom and laundry buildings.

Agency Action

The WLRD Division Director hereby approves the above-described Determination of Non-Significance Project Proposal for design and construction. The Rural and Regional Services Section fully complied with the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) Rules regarding notification, meetings, and SEPA documents for this proposal as required under WAC 197-11, RCW 43.21c, Ordinance 12196, and ESHB 1724.
