Notice of Action

Riverbend Mobile Home Park Demolition Project

Notice is hereby given under SEPA, RCW 43.21C.080, that the Water and Land Resources Division (WLRD), King County Department of Natural Resources and Parks, Capital Projects Section, took the action described in item 2 below on March 27, 2017.

1. Any action to set aside, enjoin, review, or otherwise challenge such action on the grounds of non-compliance with the provisions of Chapter 43.21C RCW shall be commenced on or before April 28, 2017.
2. The agency decision is to proceed on final design and construction of the Riverbend Mobile Home Park Demolition Project.
3. The proposed project is located at 17410 SE Renton-Maple Valley Road (State Route 169), on the south bank of the Cedar River at River Mile 7.5 (SE ¼ of Section 24, Township 23 North, Range 5 East).
4. A Determination of Non-Significance was published and opened for review and public comment from March 10, 2017 through March 24, 2017. Project support documentation and project site maps are available for review at WLRD Offices from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. weekdays. 5. A Decision to Proceed was signed on March 27, 2017 by Josh Baldi, WLRD Division Director. This Notice of Action was filed on March 31, 2017 and will continue in effect through April 28, 2017.
