Notice of Action

Jan Road Levee Setback Project

Notice is hereby given under SEPA, RCW 43.21C.080, that the Water and Land Resources Division (WLRD), King County Department of Natural Resources and Parks, took the action described in item 2 below on June 24, 2021.

1. Any action to set aside, enjoin, review, or otherwise challenge such action on the grounds of non-compliance with the provisions of Chapter 43.21C RCW shall be commenced on or before July 30, 2021.
2. The agency decision is to proceed on final design and construction of the Jan Road Levee Setback Project.
3. The proposed project is located on the Cedar River between River Miles 12.9 and 13.4, approximately 1.2 miles northwest of the Hwy 169/SR 18 interchange, in the NE ¼ of the NW ¼, Section 04, Township 22N, Range 06E.
4. A Determination of Non-Significance was issued and made available for review and public comment from June 4, 2021 through June 18, 2021. Project support documentation and project site maps are available for review at WLRD Offices from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. weekdays.
