The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) will be presenting new Preliminary FEMA flood maps for the Cedar and Green rivers in a series of three public meetings to give area residents and businesses an opportunity to review the maps and ask questions.

THE MEETING will follow an Open House format, with FEMA staff providing a short presentation. Staff members from FEMA, the cities, and King County will be available to answer your questions.

The updated maps are preliminary until the completion of an appeal period. Residents and business owners attending the meeting can learn more about the preliminary maps, including flood insurance requirements, building regulations, and the map appeal process.
