Notice of Action

Fall City Floodplain Restoration Project

Notice is hereby given under SEPA, RCW 43.21C.080, that the Water and Land Resources Division (WLRD), King County Department of Natural Resources and Parks, took the action described in item 2 below on February 18, 2021.

1. Any action to set aside, enjoin, review, or otherwise challenge such action on the grounds of non-compliance with the provisions of Chapter 43.21C RCW shall be commenced on or before March 26, 2021.
2. The agency decision is to proceed on final design and construction of the Fall City Floodplain Restoration Project.
3. The proposed project is located just downstream (north) of Fall City on both the left and right banks of the Snoqualmie River between State Route 202 (SE Redmond-Fall City Road) and State Route 203 (Fall City-Carnation Road SE) and extends from river mile 33 to river mile 34. The project is in Section 10, Township 24N, Range 07E and the NE corner of Section 15, Township 24N, Range 07E.
4. A Determination of Non-Significance was issued and made available for review and public comment from January 22, 2021 through February 5, 2021. Project support documentation and project site maps are available for review at WLRD Offices from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. weekdays. The offices are located at King Street Center, 201 South Jackson Street, Suite 600, Seattle, Washington 98104. Jo Wilhelm is the Project Ecologist and may be contacted at 206-477-4849.
5. A Decision to Proceed was issued on February 18, 2021 by Josh Baldi, WLRD Division Director. This Notice of Action was filed on February 26, 2021.
