## **Notice of Action**

### **Maury Island Aquatic Reserve Armoring Removal Project**

Notice is hereby given under SEPA, RCW 43.21C.080, that the Water and Land Resources Division (WLRD), King County Department of Natural Resources and Parks, Capital Projects Section, took the action described in item 2 below on April 13, 2017.

1. Any action to set aside, enjoin, review, or otherwise challenge such action on the grounds of non-compliance with the provisions of Chapter 43.21C RCW shall be commenced on or before May 24, 2017.
2. The agency decision is to proceed on final design and construction of the Maury Island Aquatic Reserve Armoring Removal Project.
3. The four project sites are located in the Maury Island Aquatic Reserve on Maury and Vashon Islands, Washington in Central Puget Sound. The sites are all in outer Quartermaster Harbor and are owned by King County. The locations include:
  - Lost Lake 1: 11929 SW 266<sup>th</sup> Lane in the southeast quarter of Section 25, Township 22 North, Range 2 East, Willamette Meridian (Thomas Brothers Map page 713, C5).
  - Forest Glen 1: 28728 125<sup>th</sup> Place SW in the southeast quarter of Section 36, Township 22 North, Range 2 East, Willamette Meridian (Thomas Brothers Map page 713, C5).
  - Northilla 1: No address (SW Northilla Trail) in the northeast quarter of Section 6, Township 21 North, Range 3 East, Willamette Meridian (Thomas Brothers Map page 713, F7).
  - Piner Point 2: 9805 SW Northilla Trail in the northwest quarter of Section 5, Township 21 North, Range 3 East, Willamette Meridian (Thomas Brothers Map page 713, F7).
4. A Determination of Non-Significance was published and opened for review and public comment from January 11, 2017 through February 10, 2017. Project support documentation and project site maps are available for review at WLRD Offices from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. weekdays. The offices are located at King Street Center, 201 South Jackson Street, Suite 600, Seattle, Washington 98104. Cindy Young is the Project Ecologist and may be contacted at 206-477-4859.

5. A Decision to Proceed was signed on April 13, 2017 by Josh Baldi, WLRD Division Director. This Notice of Action was filed on April 26, 2017 and will continue in effect through May 24, 2017.
