**Project Description: Fee or easement acquisition of 0.03-acre inholding Roads surplus parcel on shore of Lake Sammamish.**

Site is now being surplus by King County Road Services. Site is currently an undeveloped beachfront recreation property surrounded by Parks-owned East Lake Sammamish Trail corridor. Acquisition will create a contiguous area owned by Parks for trail amenity and mitigation/restoration purposes. Sale to a private owner would most likely result in the development of a beach area and require further impacts to the trail corridor for necessary ingress and egress.

Roads has been alerted that King County Parks is interested in acquiring the property.

**Habitat Benefit:** Possible habitat restoration.

**Recreation Benefit:** Regional trail amenities, habitat restoration and passive open space.

**Plan Priority:** The site is within the confines of the East Lake Sammamish Trail Master Plan Trail project.
