**AMENDMENT TO THE CONSERVATION FUTURES  
INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN KING COUNTY AND THE CITY OF BELLEVUE  
FOR OPEN SPACE ACQUISITION PROJECTS**

**Preamble**

The King County Council, through Ordinance 9128, has established a Conservation Futures Levy Fund and appropriated proceeds to King County, the City of Seattle and certain suburban cities through the procedures set forth in Ordinance 8867, as amended by Ordinance 14714. This amendment is entered into to provide for the allocation of additional funds made available for open space acquisition.

THIS AMENDMENT is entered into between the CITY OF BELLEVUE and KING COUNTY, and amends and attaches to and is part thereof of the existing Interlocal Cooperation Agreement entered into between the parties on the 26th day of December, 1990, as previously amended.

The parties agree to the following amendments:

**Amendment 1: Article 1. Recitals**

Two paragraphs are hereby added to the Recitals Section to provide for Conservation Futures Levy Fund allocations for the Bellevue Greenway and Open Space System Project, and the Lake Sammamish Waterfront Park Project, and hereafter reads:

- On November 19, 2007, the King County Council passed Ordinance 15975, which appropriated a total of Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$800,000) in Conservation Futures Levy proceeds to the City of Bellevue for the Bellevue Greenway and Open Space System acquisition Project. On April 7, 2008 the King County Council passed Ordinance 16052, authorizing the King County Executive to enter into interlocal agreements with the City of Seattle and the suburban cities for the disbursement of Conservation Futures Funds in Ordinance 15975.
- On November 24, 2008, the King County Council passed Ordinance 16312, which appropriated a total of Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$800,000) in Conservation Futures Levy proceeds to the City of Bellevue for the Bellevue Greenway and Open Space System acquisition Project, and Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000) in Conservation Futures Levy proceeds for the Lake Sammamish Waterfront Park acquisition Project. On April 6, 2009 the King County Council passed Ordinance 16442, authorizing the King County Executive to enter into interlocal agreements with the City of Seattle and the suburban cities for the disbursement of Conservation Futures Funds in Ordinance 16312.

**Amendment 2: Article V. Conditions of Agreement**

Section 5.1 is amended to include references to Attachment L, which lists a 2008 Conservation Futures Levy Allocation for the Bellevue Greenway and Open Space System acquisition Project, and 2009 Conservation Futures Levy Allocations for the Bellevue Greenway and Open Space System acquisition Project and the Lake Sammamish Waterfront Park acquisition Project.

**Amendment 3: Article VII. Responsibilities of County**

The first two sentences of this article are appended to include Attachment L, which lists a 2008 Conservation Futures Levy Allocation for the Bellevue Greenway and Open Space System acquisition Project, and 2009 Conservation Futures Levy Allocations for the Bellevue Greenway and Open Space System acquisition Project and the Lake Sammamish Waterfront Park acquisition Project, as follows:

Subject to the terms of this agreement, the County will provide Conservation Futures Levy Funds in the amounts shown in Attachments A through L to be used for the Projects listed in Attachments A through L. The City may request additional funds; however, the County has no obligation to provide funds to the City for the Projects in excess of the total amounts shown in Attachments A through L. The County assumes no obligation for the future support of the Projects described herein except as expressly set forth in this agreement.

**Amendment 4: Attachment L**


The attachments to the interlocal agreement are hereby amended by adding Attachment L, which is hereby attached to the interlocal agreement, incorporated therein and made a part thereof.

In all other respects, the terms, conditions, duties and obligations of both parties shall remain the same as agreed to in the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement as previously amended.

This document shall be attached to the existing Interlocal Cooperation Agreement.
