

**AMENDMENT TO THE CONSERVATION FUTURES
INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN KING COUNTY AND THE CITY OF COVINGTON
FOR OPEN SPACE ACQUISITION PROJECTS**

Preamble

The King County Council, through Ordinance 9128, has established a Conservation Futures Levy Fund and appropriated proceeds to King County and certain cities. This amendment is entered into to provide for the allocation of additional proceeds made available for open space acquisition.

THIS AMENDMENT is entered into between the CITY OF COVINGTON and KING COUNTY, and amends and attaches to and is part thereof of the existing Interlocal Cooperation Agreement entered into between the parties on the 20th day of January, 2021.

The parties agree to the following amendment:

The Interlocal Cooperation Agreement is hereby amended by adding Exhibit 1, attached hereto.

In all other respects, the terms, conditions, duties and obligations of both parties shall remain the same as agreed to in the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement as previously amended.


Once fully executed, this Amendment shall be incorporated into the existing Interlocal Cooperation Agreement as if fully set forth, and shall become Amendment 1.

Project Description:**Project #1139013 Master (Award #1141630): Covington – Crystal View Park Expansion**

The City of Covington seeks to acquire a 9.78-acre parcel that will expand Crystal View Park, providing new open space and passive recreation opportunity and allowing for removal of a partial fish passage barrier at Little Soos Creek. 7.78 acres of the site will be funded with Conservation Futures funding, reserving two acres for stormwater-related capital project purposes. Project funding was authorized in King County Ordinance 19364.
