**Preamble**

The King County Council, through Ordinance 9128, has established a Conservation Futures Fund and appropriated proceeds to King County, the City of Seattle, and certain suburban cities. Ordinance 9430 provided for the use of Conservation Futures Funds collected in the years 1990 through 1993 for the completion of projects as set forth in Ordinance 90971. This amendment is entered into to provide for the allocation of additional funds made available for project completion. The parties have agreed to amend the existing Interlocal Cooperation Agreement to provide for additions in the references to the fund allocation.

THIS AMENDMENT is entered into between the CITY OF ISSAQUAH ("City") and KING COUNTY, and amends and attaches to and is part thereof of the existing Interlocal Cooperation Agreement entered into between the parties, dated the 5th day of June, 1990.

The parties agree to the following amendments:

**Amendment 1: Article 1. Recitals**

The fourth paragraph of the Recitals Section is hereby amended to provide for the 1993 allocation, and hereafter reads:

"On October 17, 1994, the King County Council passed Ordinance 11531, which appropriated a total of \$2,500,919 in Conservation Futures Levy proceeds to King County, the City of Seattle and suburban cities. Ordinance 11531 provided \$839,869 for the Waterways 2000/Urban Program. On March 13, 1995, the King County Council passed Ordinance 11713 allocating these funds to specific city projects."

**Amendment 2: Article VII, Responsibility of County**

The first two sentences of this article are amended to include Attachment C, which lists the Waterways 2000 Project Allocation, and hereafter reads:

"Subject to the terms of this Agreement, and the conditions listed in Attachment C, the County will provide Conservation Futures Levy Funds in the amount shown in Attachments A, B and C. The City may request additional funds; however, the County has no obligation to provide funds to the City in excess of the amount shown in Attachments A, B and C."

In all other respects, the terms, conditions, duties and obligations of both parties shall remain the same as agreed to in the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement.

This document shall be attached to be a part of the existing Interlocal Cooperation Agreement.
