**AMENDMENT TO THE CONSERVATION FUTURES  
INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN KING COUNTY AND THE CITY OF KIRKLAND  
FOR OPEN SPACE ACQUISITION PROJECTS**

**Preamble**

The King County Council, through Ordinance 9128, has established a Conservation Futures Levy Fund and appropriated proceeds to King County, the City of Seattle and certain suburban cities through the procedures set forth in Ordinance 8867, as amended by Ordinance 14714. This amendment is entered into to provide for the allocation of additional funds made available for open space acquisition.

THIS AMENDMENT is entered into between the CITY OF KIRKLAND and KING COUNTY, and amends and attaches to and is part thereof of the existing Interlocal Cooperation Agreement entered into between the parties on the 2nd day of April, 1991, as previously amended.

The parties agree to the following amendments:

**Amendment 1: Article 1. Recitals**

A paragraph is hereby added to the Recitals Section to provide for a Conservation Futures Levy Fund allocation for the Kirkland Rieger Property (Yarrow Bay) open space acquisition project, and hereafter reads:

On November 21, 2005, the King County Council passed Ordinance 15333, which appropriated a total of Eighty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$82,000) in Conservation Futures Levy proceeds to the City of Kirkland for the Kirkland Rieger Property (Yarrow Bay) acquisition Project. On April 17, 2006 the King County Council passed Ordinance 15423, authorizing the King County Executive to enter into interlocal agreements with the City of Seattle and the suburban cities for the disbursement of Conservation Futures Funds in Ordinance 15333.

**Amendment 2: Article V. Conditions of Agreement**

Section 5.1 is appended to include Attachment C, which lists a 2006 Conservation Futures Levy Allocation for the Kirkland Rieger Property (Yarrow Bay) acquisition Project.

**Amendment 3: Article VII. Responsibilities of County**

The first two sentences of this article are appended to include Attachment C, which lists a 2006 Conservation Futures Levy proceeds allocation for the Kirkland Rieger Property (Yarrow Bay) acquisition Project:

Subject to the terms of this agreement, the County will provide Conservation Futures Levy Funds in the amounts shown in Attachments A through C to be used for the Projects listed in Attachments A through C. The City may request additional funds; however, the County has no obligation to provide funds to the City for the Projects in excess of the total amounts shown in Attachments A through C. The County assumes no obligation for the future support of the Projects described herein except as expressly set forth in this agreement.

In all other respects, the terms, conditions, duties and obligations of both parties shall remain the same as agreed to in the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement as previously amended.

This document shall be attached to the existing Interlocal Cooperation Agreement.





**Project Descriptions:**

**City of Kirkland - Kirkland Rieger Property (Yarrow Bay)                      \$ 82,000**

Kirkland Rieger Property (Yarrow Bay): This project is located at 97th Avenue Northeast and consists of the acquisition of approximately 3.6-acres of habitat as an addition to the City of Kirkland's 66-acre Yarrow Bay Wetland. The site is primarily wetland habitat that contains and also buffers natural shoreline on Lake Washington. There is a critical need for such habitat for the lake's wildlife and aquatic species, including natural forage for Chinook and migratory songbird habitat.
