**AMENDMENT TO THE CONSERVATION FUTURES
INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN KING COUNTY AND THE CITY OF PACIFIC
FOR OPEN SPACE ACQUISITION PROJECTS**

Preamble

The King County Council, through Ordinance 9128, has established a Conservation Futures Levy Fund and appropriated proceeds to King County, the City of Seattle and certain suburban cities. This amendment is entered into to provide for the allocation of additional funds made available for open space acquisition.

THIS AMENDMENT is entered into between the CITY OF PACIFIC and KING COUNTY, and amends and attaches to and is part thereof of the existing Interlocal Cooperation Agreement entered into between the parties on the 9th day of November, 2006.

The parties agree to the following amendments:

Amendment 1: Article 1. Recitals

Two paragraphs are hereby added to the Recitals Section to provide for three Conservation Futures Levy Fund allocations for the Pacific Trail Hub and Spokes Acquisitions project, and hereafter reads:

- On November 21, 2005 the King County Council approved Ordinance 15333, which appropriated a total of One Hundred and Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000) in Conservation Futures Levy proceeds to the City of Pacific Trail Hub and Spokes Acquisitions project. On April 17, 2006 the King County Council approved Ordinance 15423, authorizing the King County Executive to enter into interlocal agreements with the City of Seattle and the suburban cities for the disbursement of Conservation Futures Funds in Ordinance 15333.

Amendment 2: Article V. Conditions of Agreement

Section 5.1 is amended to include reference to Attachment B, which lists a 2006 Conservation Futures Levy Allocation for the Trail Hub and Spokes Acquisitions project.

Amendment 3: Article VII. Responsibilities of County

The first two sentences of this article are amended to include references to Attachment B, which lists a 2006 Conservation Futures Levy Allocation for the Trail Hub and Spokes-Acquisitions project as follows:

Subject to the terms of this agreement, the County will provide Conservation Futures Levy Funds in the amounts shown in Attachments A through B to be used for the Projects listed in Attachments A through B. The City may request additional funds; however, the County has no obligation to provide funds to the City for the Projects in excess of the total amounts shown in Attachments A through B. The County assumes no obligation for the future support of the Projects described herein except as expressly set forth in this agreement.

The attachments to the interlocal agreement are hereby amended by adding Attachment B, which is hereby attached to the interlocal agreement, incorporated therein and made a part thereof.

In all other respects, the terms, conditions, duties and obligations of both parties shall remain the same as agreed to in the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement as previously amended.

This document shall be attached to the existing Interlocal Cooperation Agreement.



Project Description:

City of PACIFIC – Trail Hub and Spokes Acquisitions

\$125,000

\$125,000 is allocated to the Trail Hub and Spokes Acquisitions project. This is a multiple-parcel project in the City of Pacific, totaling approximately 7.85 acres and parallel to State Route 167. The project consists of the acquisition of three parcels on a portion of the Interurban trail on Puget Sound Energy (PSE) railway right of way above West Valley Highway and two parcels along the Milwaukee trail PSE utility corridor between 3rd Avenue SW and the Pierce County line. The project provides a trail connection for a significant "missing link" in the interurban regional trail and also a trail connection to the White River Trail.
