

**AMENDMENT TO THE CONSERVATION FUTURES
INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN KING COUNTY AND THE CITY OF SAMMAMISH
FOR OPEN SPACE ACQUISITION PROJECTS**

Preamble

The King County Council, through Ordinance 9128, has established a Conservation Futures Levy Fund and appropriated proceeds to King County and certain cities. This amendment is entered into to provide for the allocation of additional proceeds made available for open space acquisition.

THIS AMENDMENT is entered into between the CITY OF SAMMAMISH and KING COUNTY, and amends and attaches to and is part thereof of the existing Interlocal Cooperation Agreement entered into between the parties on the 10th day of December, 2019.

The parties agree to the following amendment:


The Interlocal Cooperation Agreement is hereby amended by adding Exhibit 1, attached hereto.

The City of Sammamish seeks to create a new park in the southwest part of the city, in an area that lacks public parks and open space. The city plans to purchase two parcels containing 14.88 acres located just east of East Lake Sammamish Parkway SE. These parcels are primarily forested with mature tree canopy, and include an open meadow, seasonal streams, and a forested ravine. Project funding was authorized in King County Ordinance 19364.
