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**AMENDMENT TO THE CONSERVATION FUTURES
INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN KING COUNTY AND THE CITY OF SEATTLE
FOR OPEN SPACE ACQUISITION PROJECTS**

Preamble

The King County Council, through Ordinance 9128, has established a Conservation Futures Levy Fund and appropriated proceeds to King County, the City of Seattle and certain suburban cities through the procedures set forth in Ordinance 8867, as amended by Ordinance 13717. This amendment is entered into to provide for the allocation of additional funds made available for open space acquisition.

THIS AMENDMENT is entered into between the CITY OF SEATTLE and KING COUNTY, and amends and attaches to and is part thereof of the existing Interlocal Cooperation Agreement entered into between the parties on the 29th day of June, 1990, as previously amended.

The parties agree to the following amendments:

Amendment 1: Article 1. Recitals

A paragraph is hereby added to the Recitals Section to provide for a Conservation Futures Levy Fund allocation for the Hitts Hill acquisition, and hereafter reads:

- On December 15, 2000, the King County Council passed Ordinance 14018, which appropriated a total of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) in Conservation Futures Levy proceeds to the City of Seattle for the Hitt's Hill acquisition project. On May 28, 2002 the King County Council passed Ordinance 14369 authorizing the King County Executive to enter into an amendment to the Conservation Futures Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with the City of Seattle for Open Space Acquisition Projects to add the Hitt's Hill acquisition project authorized under ordinance 14018.

Amendment 2: Article V. Conditions of Agreement

Section 5.1 is amended to include Attachment P, which lists a 2000 Conservation Futures Levy Allocation for the Hitt's Hill Acquisition project.

Amendment 3: Article VII. Responsibilities of County

The first two sentences of this article are amended to include Attachment P, which lists a 2000 Conservation Futures Levy proceeds allocation for the Hitt's Hill Acquisition Project:

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for the Projects listed in Attachments A through P. The City may request additional funds; however, the County has no obligation to provide funds to the City for the Projects in excess of the total amounts shown in Attachments A through P. The County assumes no obligation for the future support of the Projects described herein except as expressly set forth in this agreement."

In all other respects, the terms, conditions, duties and obligations of both parties shall remain the same as agreed to in the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement as previously amended.

This document shall be attached to the existing Interlocal Cooperation Agreement.
