**AMENDMENT TO THE CONSERVATION FUTURES
INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN KING COUNTY AND THE CITY OF SHORELINE
FOR OPEN SPACE ACQUISITION PROJECTS**

Preamble

The King County Council, through Ordinance 9128, has established a Conservation Futures Levy Fund and appropriated proceeds to King County, the City of Shoreline and certain suburban cities through the procedures set forth in Ordinance 8867, as amended by Ordinance 14714. This amendment is entered into to provide for the allocation of additional funds made available for open space acquisition.

THIS AMENDMENT is entered into between the CITY OF SHORELINE and KING COUNTY, and amends and attaches to and is part thereof of the existing Interlocal Cooperation Agreement entered into between the parties on the 9th day of June, 2003.

The parties agree to the following amendments:

Amendment 1: Article 1. Recitals

A paragraph is hereby added to the Recitals Section to provide for a Conservation Futures Levy Fund allocation for the Paramount Park Addition open space acquisition, and hereafter reads:

- On July 19, 2002, the King County Council passed Ordinance 14409, which appropriated \$50,000 in Conservation Futures Levy proceeds to the City of Shoreline for the Paramount Park Addition open space Acquisition Project. On October 13, 2003 The King County Council passed Ordinance 14774, authorizing the King County Executive to enter into an amendment to the Conservation Futures Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for Open Space Acquisition Projects with the City of Shoreline for the Paramount Park Addition open space acquisition project authorized under Ordinance 14409.

Amendment 2: Article V. Conditions of Agreement

Section 5.1 is appended to include Attachment B, which lists a 2002 Conservation Futures Levy Allocation for the Paramount Park Addition open space acquisition project.

Amendment 3: Article VII. Responsibilities of County

The first two sentences of this article are appended to include Attachment B, which lists a 2002 Conservation Futures Levy proceeds allocation for the Paramount Park Addition open space acquisition project:

Subject to the terms of this agreement, the County will provide Conservation Futures Levy Funds in the amounts shown in Attachments A through B to be used for the Projects listed in Attachments A through B. The City may request additional funds; however, the County has no obligation to provide funds to the City for the Projects in excess of the total amounts shown in Attachments A through B. The County assumes no obligation for the future support of the Projects described herein except as expressly set forth in this agreement.

In all other respects, the terms, conditions, duties and obligations of both parties shall remain the same as agreed to in the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement as previously amended.

This document shall be attached to the existing Interlocal Cooperation Agreement.



Project Description:

Paramount Park Addition:

This project consists of a wooded, 0.4-acre-parcel containing a wetland area that will provide a natural buffer to the eastern edge of Paramount Park, located on 10th Avenue NE in Shoreline. The parcel will buffer a pedestrian entrance into the park on a right of way at NE 148th Street. The area is a headwater for a small tributary of a branch of Thornton Creek, which flows southwards into nearby Seattle and added protection would help maintain water recharge in the stream.

City of Shoreline – (Paramount Park Addition) \$50,000
