

**AMENDMENT TO THE CONSERVATION FUTURES
INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN KING COUNTY AND SI VIEW METROPOLITAN PARK DISTRICT
FOR OPEN SPACE ACQUISITION PROJECTS**

Preamble

The King County Council, through Ordinance 9128, has established a Conservation Futures Levy Fund and appropriated proceeds to King County and certain cities. This amendment is entered into to provide for the allocation of additional proceeds made available for open space acquisition.

THIS AMENDMENT is entered into between SI VIEW METROPOLITAN PARK DISTRICT and KING COUNTY, and amends and attaches to and is part thereof of the existing Interlocal Cooperation Agreement entered into between the parties on the 10th day of December, 2019.

The parties agree to the following amendment:


The Interlocal Cooperation Agreement is hereby amended by adding Exhibit 1, attached hereto.



Si View Metropolitan Park District (MPD) seeks to establish permanent public access along the South Fork Levee where the levee maintenance road is used by the public for walking and river access without formal access rights. The target in this proposal is to acquire a 13.5-acre undeveloped riverfront parcel in fee, containing 1,300 feet of the trail and riverfront, as part of a planned two-mile trail corridor. Project funding was authorized in King County Ordinance 19364.
