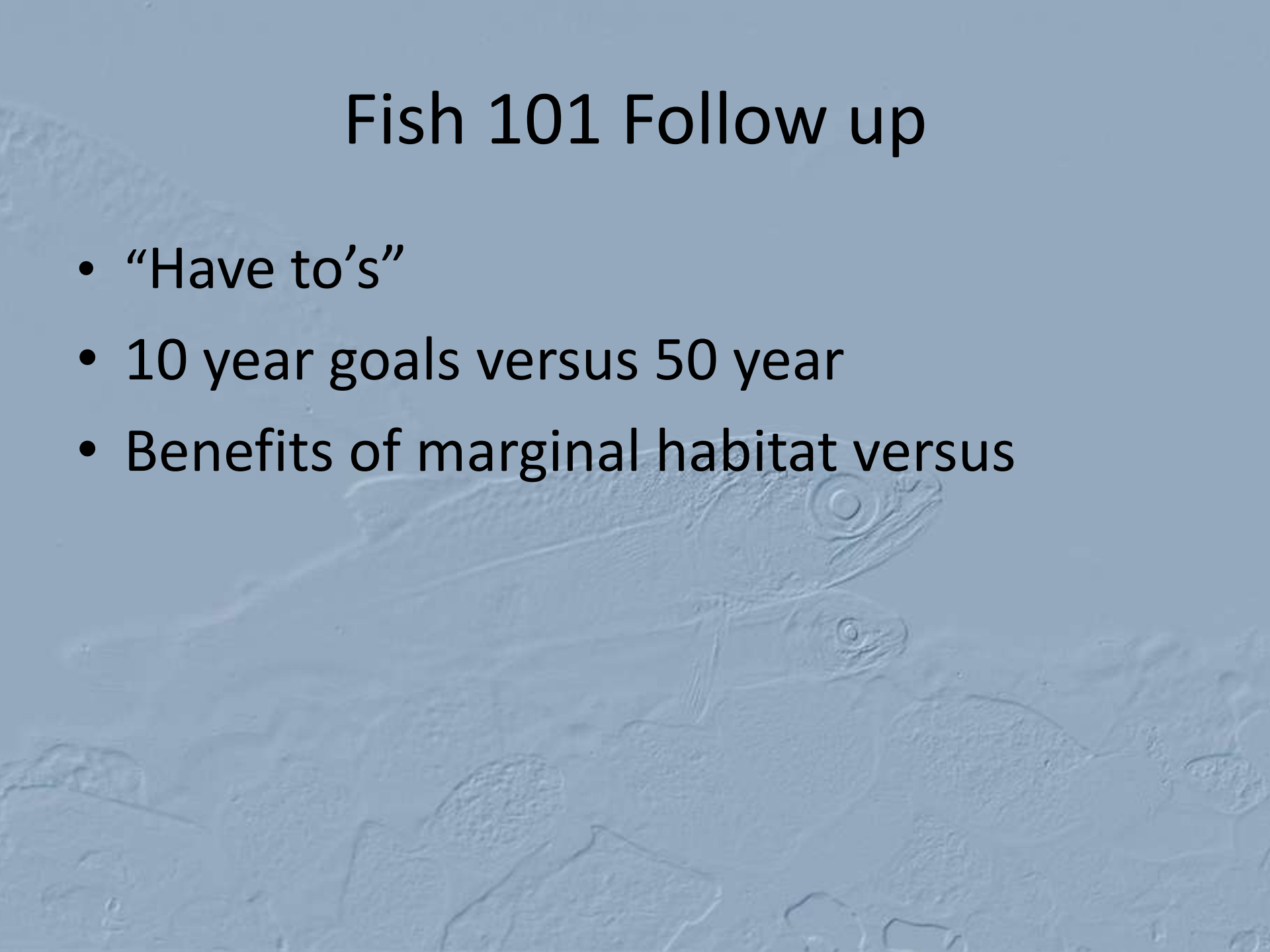

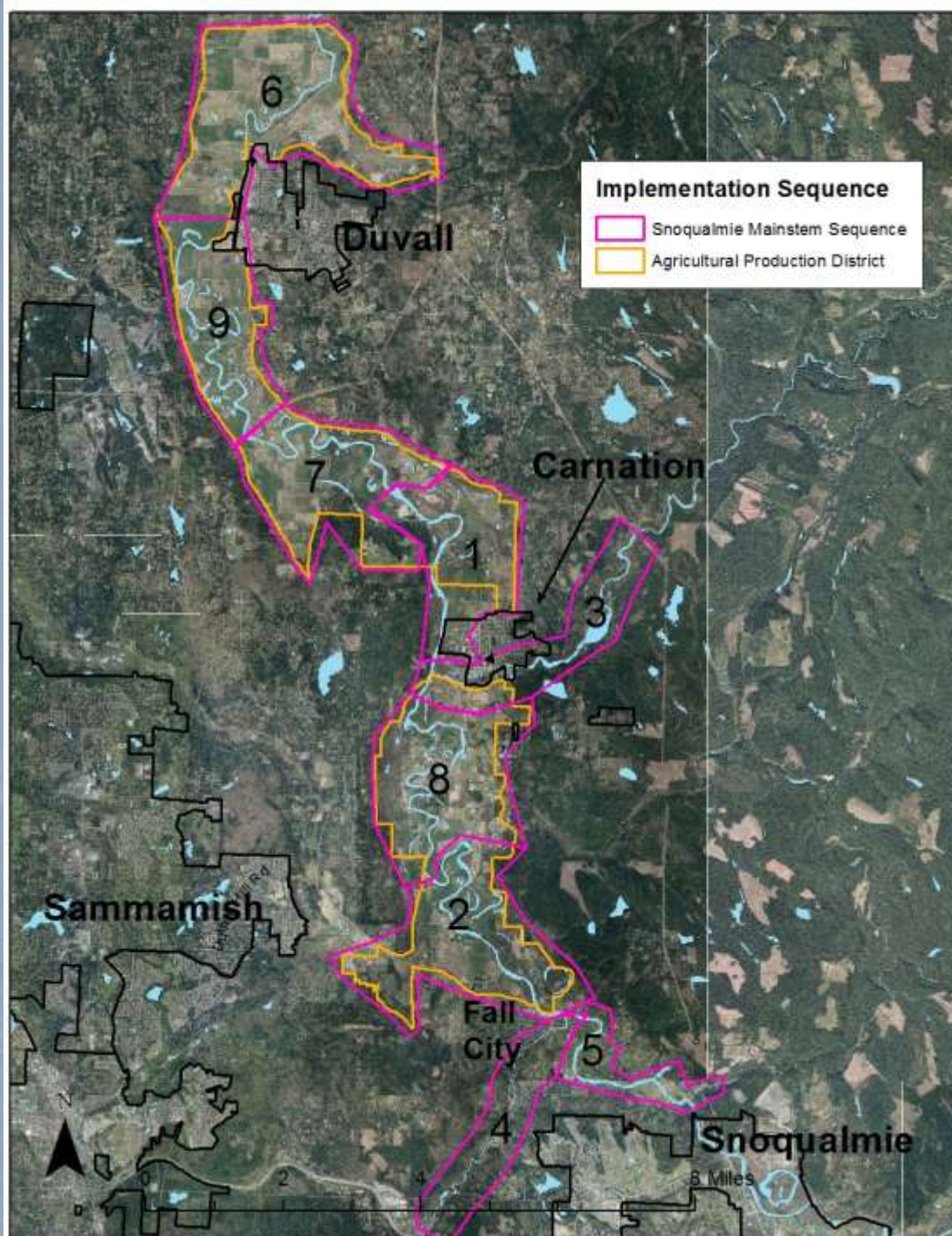

First Tier 10-year Goals (5 year progress report)

Sub-basin Strategy Group and Habitat	10 Year Habitat Goals	2005-2010 Progress
Nearshore Beaches and Shoreline	At least 1 mile	0.2 mile (20%)
Estuary: Restored Tidal Marsh	1,237 acres	375 acres (30%)
Mainstem: Restored Edge Habitat (King County Portion)	5.2 miles	1 mile (19%)
Mainstem Restored: Off-Channel Habitat (King County Portion)	84 acres	21 acres (25%)
Mainstem: Restored Riparian Habitat (King County Portion)	128 acres	81 acres (63%)
Mainstem: Large wood (King County Portion)	20 jams	8 jams (40%)

- Mainstem 1° = Snoqualmie, Lower Tolt, Raging, SF Sky
- Goals are NET gains
- 10-year goals are 20% of 50-year goals
- Actions are investments in long-term processes
- Goals overly simplified in plan (there's more under the hood)
