




Use a black ink pen to completely fill in the oval next to your choice.


How to correct a mistake

<div>King County Proposition No. 1 Children and Family Services Center Capital Levy</div> <p>The King County council passed Ordinance No. 17304 concerning a replacement facility for juvenile justice and family law services. This proposition would authorize King County to levy an additional property tax for nine years to fund capital costs to replace the Children and Family Justice Center, which serves the justice needs of children and families. It would authorize King County to levy an additional regular property tax of \$0.07 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation for collection in 2013. Increases in the following eight years would be subject to the limitations in chapter 84.55 RCW, all as provided in Ordinance No. 17304. It authorizes regular property taxes above RCW 84.55 limits, allowing additional 2013 collection of up to \$17,000,000 (approximately \$0.15/\$1,000 assessed value) and up to \$122,630,099 over seven years.
