<p>Requirements</p> <p>To register to vote in Washington, you must be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A citizen of the United States • A legal resident of Washington State • At least 18 years old by Election Day <p>How to register</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Register online with the Secretary of State, www.sos.wa.gov • Download a registration form from the King County Elections website, and return it by mail or in person • Register in person at the King County Elections office <p>Registration deadlines</p> <p>While you may register to vote at any time, there are registration deadlines prior to each election. The deadlines for the February 14, 2012, special election:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • January 16 – Deadline to register by mail or online, or to transfer or update voter registration. • February 6 – Deadline to register in-person for people who are not currently registered in Washington. You can register in-person at the Elections office in Renton or at our new Voter Registration Annex located at the King County Administration Building, 500 4th Ave., Room 311 in Seattle. <p>Keep your voter registration current</p> <p>Update your registration if you have moved or changed your name, or if your signature has changed.
