


Did you know the Cedar Hills Regional Landfill is one of the largest landfill renewable energy producers in the United States?

Climate Change Benefits

Converting previously flared landfill gas into renewable energy means that an equal amount of non-renewable energy – fossil fuels like natural gas, coal, or oil – do not need to be consumed. This reduces greenhouse gas emissions by about **82,000 metric tons** per year. It also reduces emissions of air pollutants that contribute to smog and acid rain.
