Items Must Meet the Following Guidelines.....



You Can Bring...

- **TIRES:** Bias ply, steel belted, and studded tires accepted. **Limit 6 tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge. No oversized tires accepted.**
- **MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, & ANTIFREEZE:** Motor oil, oil filters, and antifreeze only. **No gasoline, transmission fluid, brake fluid, 2-cycle oil, steering fluid, crankcase oil, kerosene, or home heating fuel. Do not mix oil with antifreeze.**
- **LEAD ACID BATTERIES:** Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted.



- **HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries only.
- **CARDBOARD:** Please flatten. No wax coated cardboard.
- **HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND CLOTHING:** Clothing and miscellaneous household items in good condition. Mattresses and furniture will not be accepted. Items in need of repair will not be accepted.
- **CONFIDENTIAL MATERIAL SHREDDING:** Shredding and recycling of confidential paper materials. **Limit 5 file-size boxes per participant.**
- **PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS:** Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed.
- **PROPANE TANKS:** Residential five gallon tanks only.
- **APPLIANCES AND SCRAP METAL:** Refrigerator, freezers, stoves, microwaves, washers and dryers, water heaters, and other appliances, metal push and gas lawnmowers, auto parts, lawn chairs, barbecues, iron, steel, aluminum, brass, copper and other ferrous and nonferrous metals. Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials will not be accepted. Light fixture ballasts and sealed drums will not be accepted.
- **ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT:** Computers, printers, mouse, keyboards, fax machines, scanners, and cellular phones. Equipment will be recycled as metal. **Computer monitors will be collected for \$10 each (cash only).**
- **TELEVISION SETS:** TV sets with 36 inch or smaller screens and encased in plastic - **\$15 charge (cash only)**. TV sets with larger than 36 inch screens, wood console, sets encased in wood, and big screen TV sets - **\$20 charge (cash only)**. **Projection TV sets - \$30 charge (cash only)**.
- **PLASTIC CONTAINERS:** Number 6 food service containers, such as hot beverage cups, egg cartons, clam shells, and meat trays. Also collected will be clear rigid food containers such as cake domes and salad containers. No Styrofoam packing materials, "peanuts" or packing frames will be accepted. Mail Boxes Etc., (7683 SE 27th) accepts Styrofoam "peanuts."
- **PLASTIC PLANT CONTAINERS:** No clay containers or broken plastic containers will be accepted.



Please note: To cover the increased recycling costs, computer monitors will be accepted for a \$10 fee.

The Factoria Transfer Station's Hazardous Waste Collection

Household hazardous waste is collected at the Factoria Transfer Station - 13800 SE 32nd Street in Bellevue. The site is open Thursday - Sunday from 9 am to 5 pm, except on holidays. The total volume of waste per customer may not exceed 30 gallons and containers larger than 5 gallons in size will not be accepted. If you have more than 30 gallons of waste at any one time you can make trips on consecutive days. 
