

## Items Must Meet the Following Guidelines.....



**You Can Bring...**

•**TIRES:** Bias ply, steel belted, and studded tires accepted. Limit 6 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge. \$1.50 charge for each tire on a rim. \$5 charged for each large truck tire and \$15 charged for each truck tire on rim (cash only). No oversized tires accepted.



•**MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, & ANTIFREEZE:** Motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze, brake fluid, transmission fluid, 2-cycle oil, steering fluid, crankcase oil, kerosene, and home heating fuel. Do not mix with antifreeze, solvents, gasoline, or other substances. Used oil or antifreeze containers will not be accepted.



- LEAD ACID BATTERIES:** Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted.
- HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries only.
- HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND CLOTHING:** Clothing and miscellaneous household items in good condition. Furniture will not be accepted. Mattresses will not be accepted. Items in need of repair will not be accepted.
- PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS:** Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed. **\$5 charge (cash only).**
- PROPANE TANKS:** Residential tanks only. **\$5 charge (cash only).**
- CARDBOARD:** Please flatten. No wax coated cardboard.
- APPLIANCES AND SCRAP METAL:** Auto parts, engines, lawn chairs, stoves, barbecues, iron, steel, aluminum, brass, copper and other ferrous and nonferrous metals. **\$5 will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating (cash only).** Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials will not be accepted. Light fixture ballasts and sealed drums will not be accepted.
- REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS:** **\$25 will be charged for each refrigerator or freezer.** \$25 will be charged for each household air conditioner **(cash only).**
- ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT:** Computers, printers, mouse, keyboards, fax machines, cellular phones, and scanners. Equipment will be recycled as metal. **Computer monitors will be collected for \$10 each (cash only).**
- TELEVISION SETS:** TV sets with 36 inch or smaller screens and encased in plastic - **\$15 charge (cash only).** TV sets with larger than 36 inch screens, wood console, sets encased in wood, and big screen TV sets - **\$20 charge (cash only).** Projection TV sets - **\$30 charge (cash only)**

### The Factoria Transfer Station's Hazardous Waste Collection


Household hazardous waste is collected at the Factoria Transfer Station - 13800 SE 32nd Street in Bellevue. The site is open Thursday - Sunday from 9 am to 5 pm, except on holidays. The total volume of waste per customer may not exceed 30 gallons and containers larger than 5 gallons in size will not be accepted. If you have more than 30 gallons of waste at any one time you can make trips on consecutive days. Please note - customer containers will not be returned at this site.
