Accepted Materials

Cardboard...Non-waxed or coated, flattened

CDs, Floppy Disks, Video Tapes

Cellular Phones...Phones, batteries, chargers, adapters

Computers & Components... Computers, monitors (\$10), keyboards, printers, mice

Confidential Materials... Shredding and recycling service for confidential paper materials. Limit of 5 file size boxes per business.

Fluorescent Lights...Fluorescent tubes and bulbs, incandescent bulbs. *Not accepted:* Broken lights and light fixture ballasts. Limit of 25 tubes per business.

Plastics...Grocery bags, stretch wrap, film, bubble wrap, shrink wrap, garment bags

Scrap Metal...Chairs, desks, file cabinets, telephones, fax machines, typewriters, adding machines, copiers, other ferrous and non-ferrous metals.


- Refrigerators and Freezers: \$25 will be charged for each refrigerator or freezer. \$25 will be charged for each household air conditioner (cash only).

Televisions

- Encased in plastic and less than 36"—\$20 each
- TV's enclosed in wood, wood console and big screen—\$25 each
- Projection TV's—\$30 each

Not Accepted

- No** hazardous materials
- No** paints
- No** sealed tanks and drums and metals that are insulated, rubber coated, contain chemicals, paint or hazardous materials
- No** broken lights or light fixture ballasts

NOTE:

One load per business.

Only the types of materials listed will be collected. **No hazardous waste will be accepted.** Call the business waste line at (206) 296-3976 if you need assistance with hazardous materials disposal.

To be eligible for the award, your business must demonstrate the following:

- Recycle at least 60% of solid waste.
- Practice six or more waste prevention strategies.
- Use six or more recycled products.
- Involve employees, suppliers, customers and/or the general public in preventing waste, recycling and using recycled products.
