



# Sammamish Recycling Collection Event

October 16, 2010 9am to 3pm  
Sunny Hills Elementary School  
3200 Issaquah-Pine Lake Road



These household wastes:

- No paint of any kind
- No scrap wood/bulky wood
- No construction/demolition debris
- No garbage
- No mattresses/furniture
- No plastic toys, hoses, etc.
- No window glass

These hazardous wastes:

- No oil based paint
- No cleaning products
- No pesticides/herbicides
- No solvents and thinners
- No household chemicals
- No fluorescent lights

Household hazardous wastes can be taken to waste collection sites in Seattle and Bellevue (Factoria). Latex paint is no longer considered hazardous waste and the household hazardous waste facilities in King County (the Wastemobile, Factoria, and two Seattle sites) no longer accept it. There is a 50 gallon limit and a gasoline limit of 30 gallons per customer per day. No containers can be over five gallons in size. For Factoria and the Wastemobile separate motor (crankcase) oil from all other fluids. At Factoria, no containers will be returned except those used for pure crankcase oil.



## Only the Following Items Will be Accepted.....



You Can Bring...

- **TIRES:** Bias ply, steel belted, and studded tires accepted. Limit 6 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge. **\$1.50 charge for each tire on a rim. \$5 charged for each large truck tire and \$15 charged for each truck tire on rim (cash only). No oversized tires accepted.**
- **MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, & ANTIFREEZE:** Motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze, brake fluid, transmission fluid, 2-cycle oil, steering fluid, crankcase oil, kerosene, and home heating fuel. Do not mix with antifreeze, solvents, gasoline, or other substances. Empty oil or antifreeze containers will not be accepted.



- **LEAD ACID BATTERIES:** Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted.
- **ALKALINE BATTERIES:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries only.
- **HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND CLOTHING:** Clothing and miscellaneous household items in good condition. Mattresses will not be accepted. Furniture and items in need of repair will not be accepted.
- **PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS:** Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed. **\$5 charge (cash only).**
- **PROPANE TANKS:** Residential five gallon tanks only. **\$5 charge (cash only).**
- **CARDBOARD:** Please flatten. No wax coated cardboard.
- **ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT:** DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, cellular phones and computer peripherals such as keyboards and mice. **Computer monitors and televisions will not be accepted. You can recycle these items for free at other locations - see the E-Cycle box for more information.**
- **REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS:** **\$25 will be charged for each refrigerator or freezer.** \$25 will be charged for each household air conditioner **(cash only).**
- **APPLIANCES AND SCRAP METAL:** Auto parts, engines and gas lawnmowers (drained of oil and gasoline), metal lawn chairs, stoves, microwaves, barbecues, steel, aluminum, brass, copper and other ferrous and non-ferrous metals. **\$5 will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating (cash only).** Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain chemicals, **gas, oil, paint, or hazardous materials** will not be accepted. Light fixture ballasts and sealed drums will not be accepted.



E-Cycle Washington!

Washington has a FREE recycling program called "E-Cycle Washington" for computers, computers monitors, laptops, and televisions. You may drop off computers, computers monitors, laptops, and televisions for free at the following E-Cycle Washington locations: 1 Green Planet, 1780 NW Maple St Issaquah, WA 98027, 425-996-3513), AtWork! Recycling (970 7th Ave NW Issaquah, WA 98027, 425-274-4020), and Goodwill Bellevue Store (14515 NE 20th St, Bellevue, WA, 98007, 425-649-2080). Please note - drop off locations and conditions may change. Quantities accepted maybe limited - call first. Please also note that computer peripherals such as keyboards, mice, and printers are not included in this program but will be accepted at City Recycling Collection Events.


