<b>Scrap Metal</b> (last stop)	Appliances such as ovens, stoves, hot water heaters, clothes washers, dryers, barbecues, metal sinks and tubs, gas-powered lawnmowers and other metal items.	<b>NO</b> car bodies, trailers or greasy metal.	Please drain all liquids and remove any plastic or rubber from metal. Refrigerators and freezers should be recycled separately.	Search database for local "Metal" recyclers.
<b>Scrap Lumber</b>	Clean, unpainted and untreated wood, plywood, pallets, dimensional lumber and crates.	<b>NO</b> dirty, painted, pressure treated, stained or laminated wood or particle board.	Nails do not need to be removed. Loads will be screened prior to acceptance.	Search database for local "Wood" recyclers.
<b>Bulky Brush and Branches</b>	Stumps, logs and tree branches that are at least 3 inches in diameter and less than 4 feet long (those items that don't normally fit in your yard debris cart).	<b>NO</b> yard debris such as grass clippings, sod, weeds, small twigs or garden waste. <b>NO</b> commercial loads.	<b>NO</b> assistance is available to unload stumps from vehicles. Search database for local "Yard Waste" recyclers.
<b>Refrigerators and Freezers</b>	Refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners.	<b>NO</b> commercial equipment. <b>NO</b> automotive air conditioning units.		Search database for local "Appliance" recyclers.
<b>Electronics</b>	CD/DVD players, VCRs, printers, scanners, keyboards, mice, phones, microwaves and other electronics.	<b>NO</b> commercial equipment. <b>NO</b> computers, laptops or televisions. <b>Fluorescent Bulbs and Tubes</b>	Compact fluorescent bulbs, fluorescent tubes and mercury and sodium vapor lamps.	<b>NO</b> lighting fixtures. <b>NO</b> ballasts.	Limit 10 bulbs per vehicle.	<b>Auburn SuperMall Wastemobile*</b> , or <a href="http://takeitbacknetwork.org">takeitbacknetwork.org</a> .
<b>Mattresses</b>	Mattresses, box springs and futons, any size.	<b>NO</b> commercial loads. <b>NO</b> furniture or frames.	Mattresses must be dry.	—
<b>Bicycles and Bicycle Parts</b>	Bicycles, all types and condition. All bicycle parts, helmets and accessories.		Bicycles are refurbished and given to charitable agencies.	Donate to Bikes for Kids, <a href="http://mvpbikesforkids.webs.com">mvpbikesforkids.webs.com</a> .
<b>Batteries</b>	Car, truck and marine lead acid batteries. Household alkaline, rechargeable and button batteries.		Please sort large quantities by type.	Rechargeable and lead acid batteries— <b>Auburn SuperMall Wastemobile.*</b>
<b>Tires</b>	Light truck, car and motorcycle tires. Rims OK. Steel-belted and studded tires accepted.	<b>NO</b> commercial loads or large tractor/truck tires.		Search database for local "Tire" recyclers.
<b>Reusable Household Goods</b>	Small working appliances, reusable clothing, shoes, pots, pans, bedding, books and toys.	<b>NO</b> broken, torn, stained, damaged or wet items. <b>NO</b> furniture, carpet or large appliances.	All items must be clean and in good enough condition for resale by a charitable organization.	Donate to local second hand store.
<b>Oil and Gas Products</b>	Motor oil, gasoline, diesel fuel, 2-cycle mix, transmission fluid, brake fluid, kerosene, antifreeze and oil filters.	<b>NO</b> unmarked or mixed liquids. <b>NO</b> commercial loads.	Do not mix any liquids together. Please seal and label containers with contents.	<b>Auburn SuperMall Wastemobile.*</b>
<b>Rigid Plastic</b>	Plastic nursery pots, flowerpots, buckets, CD cases, PVC pipe, children's plastic toys and other rigid plastic.	<b>NO</b> dirty containers, hazardous chemical containers or containers with food residue.	Remove any metal or rubber parts before recycling.	Search database for local "Plastic" recyclers.
<b>Styrofoam Blocks</b>	Clean, white Styrofoam blocks.	<b>NO</b> urethane foam cushions, expanded polypropylene or foam insulation.	Expanded polystyrene only. Look for the  .	V&G Styro Recycle, 800 SW 43rd St, Renton, <a href="http://styrorecycle.com">styrorecycle.com</a> , 253.838.9555.
<b>Packing Peanuts</b>	Clean packing peanuts.		Please keep packing peanuts in a box or bag. Must be clean and dry.	Search database for local "Packing Material" recyclers.
<b>Wires and Holiday Light Strands</b> (first stop)	Holiday light strands (with or without bulbs), lamp cords, extension cords and scrap wires.		Items will be recycled to raise money for charities. 
