


These household wastes:


- No scrap wood/yard debris
- No construction/demolition debris
- No garbage
- No mattresses/furniture
- No plastic toys, hoses, etc.
- No window glass

These hazardous wastes:

- No paint of any kind**
- No pesticides/herbicides
- No solvents and thinners
- No household chemicals
- No cleaning products
- No fluorescent lights



Only the Following Items Will be Accepted.....



You Can Bring...

- TIRES:** Bias ply, steel belted, and studded tires accepted. Limit 6 passenger tires per participant (18 inches and below) free of charge. **\$1.50 charge for each tire on a rim. \$5 charged for each large truck tire and \$15 charged for each truck tire on rim (cash only). No oversized tires accepted.**
- MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, & ANTIFREEZE:** Motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze, brake fluid, transmission fluid, 2-cycle oil, steering fluid, crankcase oil, kerosene, and home heating fuel. Do not mix with antifreeze, solvents, gasoline, or other substances. Empty used oil or antifreeze containers will not be accepted.

- LEAD ACID BATTERIES:** Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted.
- ALKALINE BATTERIES:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries only.
- HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND CLOTHING:** Clothing and miscellaneous household items in good condition. Furniture will not be accepted. Mattresses will not be accepted. Items in need of repair will not be accepted.
- PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS:** Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed. **\$10 charge for each toilet or sink (cash only).**
- PROPANE TANKS:** Residential tanks only. **\$5 charge (cash only).**
- CARDBOARD:** Please flatten. No wax coated cardboard.
- APPLIANCES AND SCRAP METAL:** Auto parts, engines and gas lawnmowers (drained of oil and gasoline), metal lawn chairs, stoves, barbecues, iron, steel, aluminum, brass, copper and other ferrous and nonferrous metals. **\$5 will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating (cash only).** Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials will not be accepted. Light fixture ballasts and sealed drums will not be accepted.
- REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS:** **\$25 will be charged for each refrigerator or freezer.** \$25 will be charged for each household air conditioner **(cash only).**
- ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT:** DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, cellular phones and computer peripherals such as keyboards and mice. **Computer monitors and televisions will not be accepted. You can recycle these items for free at other locations - see the E-Cycle box for more information.**

Household hazardous wastes can be taken to the Household Hazardous Wastemobile, the Auburn SuperMall Wastemobile, and the hazardous waste collection site in Factoria. The Factoria site is located at 13800 SE 32nd Street, Bellevue. The site is open 8 am - 4 pm Tuesday - Friday and 9 am - 5 pm Saturday and Sunday (except holidays). There is a 50 gallon limit and a gasoline limit of 30 gallons per customer per day and customers will not get their containers back. No containers can be over five gallons in size. Separate motor (crankcase) oil from all other fluids. Pure crankcase oil containers will be returned.


NOT COLLECTED: TV Sets, computers and monitors, and laptops. These items are collected free of charge through the E-Cycle Washington program.



E-Cycle Washington

Washington has a FREE recycling program called "E-Cycle Washington" for computers, computers monitors, laptops, and TVs. Call 1-800-RECYCLE or visit 1800recycle.wa.gov to find authorized E-Cycle Washington collection locations. You may drop off computers, computers monitors, laptops, and televisions for free at the following E-Cycle Washington location: Goodwill Newport Hills Donation Center (5115 112th Place SE, Bellevue, WA 98006, 206-329-1000) and Goodwill Bellevue Store (14515 NE 20th St, Bellevue, WA, 98007, 425-649-2080). Please note - drop off locations and conditions may change. Please also note that computer peripherals such as keyboards, mice, and printers are not included in this program but will be accepted at Newcastle Recycling Collection Events.


