Only the Following Items Will be Accepted...



You Can Bring...

• **TIRES:** Limit 6 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge. \$2.00 charge for each tire on a rim (*cash only*). \$5 charged for each large truck tire and \$15 charged for each truck tire on rim (*cash only*). No oversized tires accepted.

• **LEAD ACID BATTERIES:** Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted.

• **ALKALINE BATTERIES:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries only. Also accepted are rechargeable batteries and cellphone batteries.

• **MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, & ANTIFREEZE:** Motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze, brake fluid, transmission fluid, 2-cycle oil, steering fluid, crankcase oil, kerosene, and home heating fuel. Do not mix with antifreeze, solvents, gasoline, or other substances.

• **CARDBOARD:** Please flatten. No wax coated cardboard.

• **PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS:** \$15 charge (*cash only*). Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed.

• **PROPANE TANKS:** Residential tanks only. \$5 charge (*cash only*).

• **BULKY WOOD:** Includes tree branches (minimum 6 inches in diameter), logs, clean wood, plywood, pallets, and other untreated and unpainted wood. **No leaves, grass, small branches, sod, brush, painted, or stained wood.** Please lay a tarp under material for ease of removal.

• **APPLIANCES AND SCRAP METAL:** Household appliances, auto parts, engines, metal lawn chairs, stoves, barbecues, gas lawnmowers (drained of oil and gasoline), iron, steel, aluminum, brass, copper and other ferrous and nonferrous metals. **\$5 (*cash only*) will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating.** Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain **gas, oil**, chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials will not be accepted. Light fixture ballasts and sealed drums will not be accepted.

• **REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS:** \$25 (*cash only*) will be charged for each refrigerator or freezer. \$33 (*cash only*) will be charged for each household air conditioner (*cash only*). Please be prepared to pay at event entrance.

• **ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT:** DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, and cellular phones (**remove personal information**). Computers, computer monitors (**no charge**), mouse, and keyboards.

• **TELEVISION SETS:** TV sets encased in plastic, wood console, sets encased in wood, and big screen TVs accepted (**no charge**).

• **FLUORESCENT LIGHTS:** Fluorescent tubes and bulbs, incandescent bulbs. Broken lights and light fixture ballasts will not be accepted.

• **MATTRESSES:** Mattresses and box springs, any size. Fee: \$15 per mattress and \$15 per box spring (*cash only*). Vendor reserves the right to refuse any item it cannot recycle. No furniture or frames. No wet or soiled items.



These household wastes:

No construction/demolition debris

No garbage

No furniture

No plastic toys, hoses, etc.

No window glass

These hazardous wastes:

No oil based paint/solvents

No pesticides/herbicides

No household chemicals

No cleaning products

Household Hazardous Wastes (but not latex paint) can be taken to the Household Hazardous Waste mobile or one of the household hazardous waste collection sites. Skykomish residents may use the Seattle Household Hazardous Waste Facilities and the King County Wastemobile. Washington has a FREE recycling program called "E-Cycle Washington" for computers, computer monitors, laptops, and TVs. Call 1-800-RECYCLE or visit 1800recycle.wa.gov to find authorized E-Cycle Washington collection locations. You may drop off computers, computer monitors, laptops, and televisions at no charge at the following E-Cycle Washington locations: St. Vincent de Paul (17150 West Main St, Monroe, WA 98272, 360-794-5723) and Goodwill Monroe Store (14751 Chain Lake Road SE, Monroe, WA 98272, 360-794-6834). Please note - drop off locations and charges may change and quantities accepted may be limited. Please also note that computer peripherals such as keyboards, mice, and printers are not included in this program but will be accepted at the City Recycling Collection Event. Beware, it is always a good idea to delete or remove all personal information from any item you are recycling - better safe than sorry.
